MARKET 2010 will be taking place February 19-21 at the Royal Academy of Art in central Stockholm for the fifth consecutive year. MARKET has become the most important art fair at the expansive Nordic contemporary art scene and has gained an excellent reputation internationally. Every year MARKET brings together the leading galleries in the Nordic region and has established itself as a dynamic meeting place for galleries, artists, collectors and art lovers. MARKET 2009 was very well received and showed record figures both in visitors' numbers and in sales.

MARKET took place for the first time in 2006 on the initiative of a group of Swedish gallery owners aiming to create a high quality contemporary art fair for the Nordic galleries. Each year the presence of non-Swedish galleries has steadily risen. Last fair 9 of the 32 participating galleries were from outside of Sweden and our vision for the 2010 edition is to further strengthen the presence of galleries from our neighboring Nordic countries.

The planning for MARKET 2010 is now in progress and beside the main fair MARKET will include the following departments; **MARKET Emerging** – for newly established galleries on the young and dynamic Nordic art scene; **MARKET Editions & Multiples** – for galleries working with high quality editions and multiples; and **MARKET at large** – where participating galleries get a possibility to display art work that may be difficult to show in a regular stand, such as art projects, sculptures and installations. MARKET will also be arranging a series of seminars during the fair days.

We are looking forward to welcoming you to next year's main art event – MARKET 2010.
