The **MARKET** art fair will be held February 13-15, 2009, at The Royal Art Academy in central Stockholm, Sweden. **MARKET** gathers every year the absolute top echelon of Swedish galleries, exhibiting Scandinavian, as well as international contemporary art of the highest quality.

This year we also have the pleasure of welcoming a selection of galleries from our neighbouring Nordic countries, such as Galleri Christina Wilson, Copenhagen; Larm Galleri, Valby; Galleria Heino, Helsinki; and Lautom Contemporary, Oslo, who participate for the first time. We are also happy to welcome back Gallery Ahnava, Helsinki; Galleri Bo Bjerggaard, Copenhagen; Galleri Opdahl, Stavanger; Galleri Riis, Oslo; and i8, Reykjavik. From Sweden we have the leading galleries participating.

This year's edition of **MARKET** will present a couple of novelties, beside the main fair:

MARKET Emerging is a section for newly established galleries, where we put the young and expansive Scandinavian art scene in the spotlight. Participants are Galleri Niklas Belenius and Nordin Gallery, Stockholm; Larm Galleri, Valby (Copenhagen); and Lautom Contemporary, Oslo.

MARKET Editions & Multiples is geared towards galleries working with high quality editions and multiples. This year we welcome dep,art,ment, Stockholm; and Atelje Larsen, Helsingborg to this section.

MARKET At Large gives the possibility for participating galleries to put artworks on display that may be difficult to show in a standard booth. Exhibiting artists will be Per Inge Bjørlo, Kari Cavén, Wim Delvoye, Lukas Göthman, Gunilla Klingberg, Håkan Rehnberg, Anders Sletvold Moe, and Ulrika Sparre.

Seminars at MARKET are offered on Friday and Saturday, February 13-14, 12.30-1.30 pm. The topic for Friday will be Museums and Architecture and on Saturday there will be a discussion about Nordic art. The seminars will be held in Swedish.

Gallery Night in Stockholm is organised for the second year. Many of the Stockholm galleries will stay open till 8pm for exhibitions and openings. Find more information on www.market-art.se
